As per the City of Satsuma Ordinance #377, article 1,

34-2

“it is declared unlawful for any person to set fire to, burn or cause to be burned any fields, wooded area or any other lots or land, or any combustible materials thereon, within the city or within police jurisdiction of the city limits, for the purpose of clearing or cleaning such land, or for any other purpose without having first obtained a written permit from the city inspector to set fire or carry on such burning”

34-3 b

“It is the intent of this section to control burning before or during construction or demolition of any building and clearing of any land. No waste materials or rubbish, including but not limited to, debris from demolished buildings or refuse resulting from clearing of land and garbage shall be disposed of by burning without a permit”

34-4

“The city inspector shall have the authority to issue required permits to burn. The city inspector may also prohibit any and all outdoor fires when, in his opinion, conditions make such fires hazardous”

58-5 a

Burning of leaves and limbs shall be permitted provided that the owner shall monitor the burning and extinguish the fire properly when completed so as to not allow the fire to smolder and create a nuisance.
