MINUTES OF June 16, 2015

Joint Work Session

The City Council of the City of Satsuma, Alabama, convened in the Joint Work Session with Satsuma Board of Education at the school's central office at 220 Baker Road in said city at 4:30 p.m. the 16th day of June, 2015. Those present were: Mayor Paul Murray and Councilmembers: William Hamblin, Mike Butler, Matt Dial, and Tom Williams. Councilmember Black was absent. Dr. Joe Walters, Superintendent of the Satsuma School System gave a presentation on the school year which ended May, 2015.

Approval of Minutes

MAYOR'S AND COUNCIL'S REPORT:

Mayor:

1. Report on hazardous discharge running through Third Street ditch

Mayor Murray stated that a resident reported an unusual discharge running through the Third Street ditch. Upon inspection, a determination was made to contact Saraland Hazmat team who then contacted ADEM. It was discovered that contractors at the Satsuma High School discarded a floor stripping agent into the stormwater drain. A cleanup crew was called and the ditch was remediated. An ADEM representative stated that the city acted appropriately.

2. Report on striping of the county portion of Old Highway 43.

Mayor Murray reported that he recently sent a letter to Commissioner Ludgood requesting the county to stripe the north portion of Old Highway 43. He stated that he has received confirmation from Commissioner Ludgood that the county will have a contractor come out and stripe the county's portion of Old Highway 43.

Parks:

1. Councilmember Hamblin stated that each member received a letter from the Library Board suggesting that the city look at giving Cindy Ingram a raise. Ms. Ingram has

received her bachelor's degree. Councilmember Hamblin stated the matter was discussed in pre-council and the matter will be reviewed.

Public Safety:

Councilmember Butler stated that there is an invoice in the bills to be paid for \$1925.00 for turn out gear. He stated that the gear was due to the firefighters responding to a hazardous material call which compromised their gear. He stated that the company involved in the accident will be reimbursing the city for the expenses

Councilmember Butler reported that the fish fry for Officer Troy Willcutt's wife was a success due to the support of the community and surrounding businesses. He stated over \$12,000 was raised between fish plates and raffle tickets sold for various items. Councilmember Butler stated that in a recent update on Ms. Willcutt's condition, doctors are saying she has between four to six weeks.

Municipal Services:

Councilmember Dial expressed condolences to the family of Billy Reeves.

Administration:

Councilmember Williams reminded everyone of the municipal dinner to be held on Thursday at the Mobile City/County building.
