Notice of Public Hearing

The public will take notice that the Satsuma City Council will conduct a public hearing in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 5464 Old Highway 43 at 6:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as feasible on March 14, 2016. The purpose of the public hearing is to receive public input on the proposed construction of a new public safety complex. The Council has hired Engineering Design Technologies (EDT) to provide the city with a conceptual design and cost estimates which will be presented at the meeting. All interested persons are invited to attend and will be given reasonable opportunity to be heard.
