Special Called Meeting of the Satsuma City Council

The City Council of the City of Satsuma, Alabama convened in a special session in city hall in the said city on 30th day of August 2016 at 12.30 P.M. to discuss a development in the sidewalk grant.

The City Clerk was also present. A quorum was present and in the absence of the Mayor, Mayor Pro Tem Williams opened the meeting for the transaction of business.

Mayor Pro Tem Williams stated that the purpose of the meeting was to hear from the representatives from Civil Southeast, LLC regarding some developments that occurred yesterday when ALDOT visited the construction site.

Chase Cotton and Aubrey English were present for Civil Southeast. Mr. Cotton began by stating that yesterday ALDOT visited the site where there is a culvert on Highway 43. He stated that ALDOT initially said that the area around the culvert would need additional rip rap and there would be an additional cost to the city of about \$35,000. He stated since then Tom Briand and James Elmore have been in discussions with ALDOT and ALDOT agreed to shift the ditch away from the road which will mean less rip rap will be needed. He stated that now the additional cost will be approximately \$12,000.00. Mr. Cotton stated that they have discussed with the City that the amount of \$26,000 listed for the Alternate (which was the sidewalk going down Dogwood into Wright Park) might be needed to complete the project. He stated that the \$12,000 would come from that amount. Mr. Cotton also stated
