Mayor Williams stated that after the meeting OAC meeting this afternoon with EDT and the Contractor, a letter was presented from EDT asking for the City to pay \$5,960.00 for them to revise the electrical, fire safety, structural and architectural items to produce a new drawing for the enclosed sally port. The drawings are needed so that contractor can complete the enclosure. Mayor Williams stated that this matter needs immediate consideration since this could hold up the construction process.

Council went into executive session to discuss pending litigation at 6:30 p.m. Council reconvened at 6:45 and continues the special called meeting.

Mayor Williams then called to consideration of the proposal of the letter from EDT. Councilmember Little made a motion to approve paying for the amendment #2 for the Additional Engineering and Architectural Services to provide drawings for the enclosure of the Sally Port and to reserve our right to protest this at a later date. Councilmember Reese seconded the motion and it carried.

Before closing, Chief Harrell presented another item for consideration. He presented Council with 5 quotes to install security access on the doors at the Public Safety Building. Chief Harrell stated that he has been working on this for over a month and has finally gotten the quotes. He stated that the contractor is pushing to move forward with this. The quotes received were as follows:
