

PLEASE READ BEFORE ENTERING THE SATSUMA PUBLIC LIBRARY:

In accordance with Governor Kay Ivey's "Safer at Home Order", the Alabama Public Library Services and the CDC recommendations, the Satsuma Public Library will reopen on **Monday, May 18th** while adhering to the following guidelines:

LIBRARY HOURS:

MONDAY, WEDNESDAY & THURSDAY – 10:00 A.M. TO 2:00 P.M.

ENTRANCE AND EXIT OF BUILDING:

Staff can enter and exit the building to obtain material and work with members of the public on an appointment basis using appropriate distancing procedures and personal protective equipment. Masks are recommended for all who enter the building. There are NO PUBLIC RESTROOMS AVAILABLE AT THIS TIME.

FRONT DESK SERVICES:

The following services will be available by appointment (preferred). If patron shows up with no appointment, they may have to wait. ONLY 2 patrons are allowed in the library at one time. We are available for: copies, prints, fax and scans, Notary Service.

COMPUTER LAB:

Our computer lab is closed until further notice. We are making one computer available in the front lobby for completing the 2020 Census, and any other time sensitive documents. Computer use is by (preferred) appointment only and is limited to 30 minutes.

BOOKS:

We will provide curbside book service at a later date to be announced. At this time there will be no checking in/out books.
