

RESOLUTION 2020-09-04
A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN EMERGENCY CONTRACT

WHEREAS, Hurricane Sally impacted the City on September 16, 2020 causing widespread and substantial damage throughout the City. and

WHEREAS, Governor Ivey issued an Executive Order declaring a State of Emergency in the State of Alabama and the City of Satsuma issued a State of Local Emergency by Resolution 2020-09-03 on September 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, The City is in an emergency situation to allow the immediate removal of hurricane debris from City Streets. The City has an existing competitively bid contract with Greenco to remove the debris but it does not have a competitively bid debris monitoring contract in place. Under current FEMA regulations a debris monitoring contract is required to be competitively bid in order to enable the City to qualify for reimbursement. The City of Satsuma has determined that the delay and or failure to remove the existing hurricane debris located throughout the City jeopardizes the health, safety and welfare of its citizens. As such, the City hereby declares an emergency within the FEMA regulations providing for the execution of a non-competitively bid contract to alleviate the emergency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SATSUMA, ALABAMA, WHILE IN SPECIAL CALLED MEETING ON September 19, 2020 at 10:00 A.M.

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized by this resolution, as well as Resolution 2020-09-03, to execute a contract with Goodwyn, Mills, and Cawood or another qualified provider for debris monitoring services to monitor the debris removal work by Greenco which is scheduled to begin Monday, September 21, 2020.
